BACKGROUND

Gasshuku

Gasshuku (Japanese) means "intensive training together."

Historical background

1960s-1970s

Claude Thomas, a great karateka and friend of Kasé Senseï, often travelled to Japan to practice karate. Kasé Senseï asked him to develop karate in Côte d'Ivoire, which Claude Thomas worked on for 4 years. Upon his return to France, he decided to organize seminars in Frejus, his hometown on the French Riviera.

Every year Kasé Senseï, Shirai Senseï, Naito Senseï and Enoeda Senseï would come to France to teach karate in those international seminars that brought together karatekas from France all over the world. The event gained popularity, with French media attending every year to cover the seminar.

Lavorato Senseï attended every seminar as well, since he was already a student of Kase Senseï.

Serge Thomas, son of Claude Thomas and student of Lavorato Senseï, was also there. Serge has also trained with Kagawa Shihan on multiple occasions in the 1980s-90s and has now become a dear friend to JKS France Sud.

Today

Our goal this year is to recapture the legacy of past achievements, while taking advantage of the valuable ressources we have today.

Gasshukus have always been a way to bring people together around a shared passion for karate. This one will allow everyone to learn from Kagawa Shihan, Lavorato Senseï, and Arimoto Senseï.

JKS France Sud, with the FFK (French Federation of Karate) have already collaborated in the past, when we organized seminars featuring both Kagawa Shihan and Lavorato Senseï as lead instructors. We now have the opportunity to push the collaboration even further through this project.

It is also a way for us karatekas to show that we do not need to be featured in Olympic Games to promote and practice our sport at the highest levels, and bring people together while doing so.



OUR SENSEÏS



Masao Kagawa Shihan, 9th dan

Kagawa Shihan earned the World Champion title several times both in *kumite* and *kata*. When founder of JKS Asaï Senseï passed away, Kagawa Shihan became his successor as head of the federation.

He was also the official coach of Japan's national karate team and trained a number of great champions.

Kagawa Shihan is considered as one of the greatest karatekas in the world.



Jean Pierre Lavorato Senseï, 10th dan

Jean-Pierre Lavorato started karate in 1962. In 1966, he went to Japan with three friends from France's national karate team, and they trained together in Japan for several months. He became one of Nakayama Senseï's students, and consistently trained with other masters at JKA in Japan.

Upon his return to France, he won several international competitions. Soon enough, he met Kase Senseï and trained as his student for 40 years. His karate has been shaped by thousands hours of training with his master.



Koji Arimoto Senseï, 5th dan

Koji Arimoto was only 20 years old in 2012 when he earned the World Champion title with his teammates in Paris. The Japanese team performed Unsu for the final, and made history, with Kagawa Shihan as their coach. Koji Arimoto started teaching at JKS and after a break from team competitions, he and his teammates won the World Champions title again in 2021, 2023 and 2024.

Each Senseï will be conducting a class in a different dojo*. They will each be teaching their own group.

There will be 3 different classes happening simultaneously, and participants will choose who they want to train with at the beginning of each day.


PRICE & PAYMENT

(There is a train between Saint-Raphaël and Fréjus, 3-minute ride.) *You can purchase train tickets on SNCF Connect or Trainline*.




Airports
